#### All :Glory to you, O Lord

2Jesus took with him Peter and James and John, and led them up a high mountain apart, by themselves. And he was transfigured before them,

3and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no one on earth could bleach them.

4And there appeared to them Elijah with Moses, who were talking with Jesus.
